Beg through Prizewinner, any school): one dancer will perform 2 steps of a reel, one will perform 2 steps of a treble jig, and one will perform a traditional set of their choice. Soft and heavy dances will be 2 at a time, and trad set may be also, if possible. There will be 3 judges as it is a championship! All team members must register individually.

<i>Step Down the Line Championship for Open and Prelim Dancers</i>	
Open to ALL prelim and open champions! Dancers will dance one step of a slip jig or reel down the line and one of a treble jig or hornpipe down the line (2 at a time, 16 bars each) and a set of choice. Boys and Girls and prelim and Opens will be combined. Top ½ of dancers will be awarded as well as top Prelim dancer.

Adult Competition

Adult dancers must meet one of the following criteria

1. Dancers must not have taken Irish Dancing lessons as a juvenile and must be at least 18 years of age on January 1, 2026
2. Dancers may have taken lessons as a juvenile but have not competed in any competition, solo or teams, feisanna or Oireachtaisi, except competitions specifically designated for adults within the past 5 years and must be at least 18 years of age as of January 1, 2025.
